CELEBRATION OF THE ETSE GOALS FINAL CONFERENCE THE 20TH OF MAY IN SEVILLA

On May 20th, 2025, the City of Knowledge at Dos Hermanas, Sevilla hosted the final conference of the ETSE GOALS project, marking the conclusion of a meaningful and collaborative European journey. Organized by ACES-Andalusia, the project coordinator, the event brought together educators, social economy professionals, and international partners to celebrate achievements, reflect on lessons learned, and look toward the future.

A Day of Exchange, Learning, and Impact

The day opened with a warm institutional welcome by ACES-Andalusia, representatives from regional and municipal authorities. One of the highlights of the event was a roundtable focused on the winning initiative of the ETSE GOALS International Social Impact Award. A second roundtable discussed the role of service-learning in social economy organizations, offering perspectives from the educational, academic, and NGO sectors. The speakers highlighted how service-learning activities can foster active citizenship, and stronger community ties.



The afternoon sessions were dedicated to presenting the final outcomes of the ETSE GOALS project. The European partners shared the key deliverables developed over the course of the project:

- The database of good practices for integrating the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) into vocational education;
- The MOOC on service-learning for the social economy and the SDGs;
- The policy recommendations to support systemic change in how entrepreneurial education is delivered;
- Reflections on the dissemination and long-term impact of the project.
